The Church Against Culture?

Luke 9:51-56

As the time drew near for him to ascend to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem. He sent messengers ahead to a Samaritan village to prepare for his arrival. But the people of the village did not welcome Jesus because he was on his way to Jerusalem. When James and John saw this, they said to Jesus, "Lord, should we call down fire from heaven to burn them up?" But Jesus turned and rebuked them and said, "You do not know what kind of spirit you are of; for the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them."

John 16:7-8

I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I am leaving; for if I do not leave, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. And **He, when He comes, will convict the world regarding sin, and righteousness, and judgment.**

You are Not Their Judge

1 Cor. 5:9-13

I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people; ¹⁰ I *did* not at all *mean* with the sexually immoral people of this world, or with the greedy and swindlers, or with idolaters, for then you would have to leave the world. ¹¹ But actually, I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called brother if he is a sexually immoral person, or a greedy person, or an idolater, or is verbally abusive, or habitually drunk, or a swindler—not even to eat with such a person. ¹² For what *business* of mine *is it* to judge outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within *the church*? ¹³ But those who are outside, God judges.

- They have not agreed to Jesus' moral code.
- It is not your role to police them.
 - Because you do not judge, condemn, or police them does not mean you condone their behavior.
- They are Not Your Enemy

Jesus Came to Save and Heal, Not Condemn and Destroy

John 3:16-17

John 17:14-18

I have given them your word. And the world hates them because they do not belong to the world, just as I do not belong to the world. ¹⁵ I'm not asking you to take them out of the world, but to keep them safe from the evil one. ¹⁶ They do not belong to this world any more than I do. ¹⁷ Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth. ¹⁸ Just as you sent me into the world, I am sending them into the world.
