Purpose: the reason for which something or someone exists...

- Invigorating
- Inspiring
- Confusing
- Overwhelming
- Paralyzing

"What do I want to do with my life?"

Ambition: a strong desire to achieve something...

The language of purpose and ambition often highlight words like *dreams, goals, and believing in yourself...*

"Our imagination and hope become a reality if we have the courage to believe and take action to realize them..."

"Dreaming is good; dream more. Never forget that dreams have little value until you take action to realize those dreams..."

"All you need in life is two-step action: Dream and then make it happen!"

"Ambition is a very dangerous thing because either you achieve it and your life ends prematurely, or you don't, in which case your life is a constant source of disappointment. You must never have ambtion."

We urge you, brothers and sisters, to do so more and more, ¹¹ and to make it your ambition to lead a quiet life: You should mind your own business and work with your hands, just as we told you, ¹² so that your daily life may win the respect of outsiders

¹⁴ But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth.¹⁵ Such "wisdom" does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. ¹⁶ For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.

1 Cor. 7:17, 20-24

¹⁷Each of you should **continue to live in whatever situation the Lord has placed you, and remain as you were** when God first called you. This is my rule for all the churches...

²⁰ Yes, each of you should **remain as you were when God called you.** ²¹ Are you a slave? Don't let that worry you—but if you get a chance to be free, take it. ²² And remember, if you were a slave when the Lord called you, you are now free in the Lord. And if you were free when the Lord called you, you are now a slave of Christ.²³ God paid a high price for you, so don't be enslaved by the world. ²⁴ Each of you, dear brothers and sisters, should **remain as you were when God first called you.**

Gamaliel's Rule: Be Careful That You Are Not Fighting Against God

Acts 5:33-39

The high council was furious and decided to kill them (the apostles). ³⁴ But one member, a Pharisee named Gamaliel, who was an expert in religious law and respected by all the people, stood up and ordered that the men be sent outside the council chamber for a while. ³⁵ Then he said to his colleagues, **"Men of Israel, take care what you are planning to do** to these men! ³⁶ Some time ago there was that fellow Theudas, who pretended to be someone great. About 400 others joined him, but he was killed, and all his followers went their various ways. The whole movement came to nothing.³⁷ After him, at the time of the census, there was Judas of Galilee. He got people to follow him, but he was killed, too, and all his followers were scattered.

"So my advice is, leave these men alone. Let them go. If they are planning and doing these things merely on the Their own, it will soon be overthrown. ³⁹ But if it is from God, you will not be able to overthrow them. **You may** even find yourselves fighting against God!"
