1 Cor. 2:12-16

¹² And we have received God's Spirit (not the world's spirit), so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us...Those who are spiritual can evaluate (understand) all things, but they themselves cannot be evaluated (understood) by others. ¹⁶ For, "Who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enogh to teach him?" But we understand these things, because we have the mind of Christ.

Ephesians 1:17-18

I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance. ¹⁹ I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him. ⁴ They will rebuild the ancient ruins, repairing cities destroyed long ago.

They will revive them,

though they have been deserted for many generations.

Chain-Breakers, Stronghold-Stormers

Isaiah 58:6

Free those who are wrongly imprisoned; lighten the burden of those who work for you. Let the oppressed go free, and break every chain that binds people!

2 Cor. 10:3-5

1 Cor. 12:4-7, 11

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit is the source of them all. ⁵ There are different kinds of service, but we serve the same Lord. ⁶ God works in different ways, but it is the same God who does the work in all of us. ⁷ A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other... ¹¹ It is the one and only Spirit who distributes all these gifts.
