Put on salvation as your helmet (Eph. 6:17)

1 Thess. 5:6-11

⁶ So <u>be on your guard</u>, not asleep like the others. <u>Stay alert and be clearheaded</u>. ⁷ Night is the time when people sleep, and drinkers get drunk. ⁸ But let us who live in the light be <u>clearheaded</u>, protected by the armor of faith and love, and wearing as our helmet the <u>confidence of our salvation</u>. ⁹ For God chose to save us through our Lord Jesus Christ, <u>not to pour out his anger on us</u>. ¹⁰ Christ died for us so that, whether we are dead or alive when he returns, we can live with him forever. ¹¹ <u>So encourage each other and build each other</u> up, just as you are already doing.

Head Games and Propaganda in War

Propaganda in wartime must seek to demoralize enemy morale. A **primary objective of propaganda aimed at enemy nations is to break down their will to fight.** It seeks to lower the enemy's will to resist and it does it in several ways. **One is to picture the military successes on the propagandist's side**. Another is to **picture the armed might and economic power of the enemy that one must face.** Yet another is to **picture the moral superiority of the cause against which the enemy is fighting.** It is part of a nation's strategic plan to **intimidate** enemy leaders, to **separate** them from their people, and to break down resistance by producing evidence that the mass of the enemy people has been deceived and misled.

FEAR & DEFEATISM

"England is ripe for invasion. ... You might as well expect help from an army of mastodons as from the United States. ... You are on a doomed ship. ... Whether or not the people of Britain want to see their fields turned into graveyards and their cities into tombs is a matter for themselves and Mr. Churchill. Perhaps if the British people could speak, they would ask for peace. But since the official voice of England asks not for peace but for destruction, it is destruction we must provide." (July 1940 Berlin Broadcaster Lord Haw-Haw – broadcast picked up in London)

COMFORT & FULFILLMENT

It is the autumn of 1941. The United States is still neutral, but an American Army is in training, a Navy is being strengthened, and Lend-Lease supplies are crossing the Atlantic. An American sits at home tinkering with his short-wave set and he picks up an English-language broadcast beamed to North America from Germany. *"The German government and the German people have only the friendliest of feelings for the United States, the home of so⁻ many American citizens of German descent. Let it be said for once and all," that a German victory in this war is no threat to English democracy—and certainly not to American democracy." (October 1941)*
