The Unpardonable Sin Against the Holy Spirit

Three Texts to Understand Context

Mark 3:20-30 And

He *came home, and the crowd *gathered again, to such an extent that they could not even eat a meal. ²¹ And when His own people heard *about this*, they came out to take custody of Him; for they were saying, "He has lost His senses." ²² The scribes who came down from Jerusalem were saying, "He is possessed by Beelzebul," and "He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons." ²³ And *so* He called them to Himself and *began* speaking to them in parables: "How can Satan cast out Satan? ²⁴ And if a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. ²⁵ If a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. ²⁶ And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but he is finished!²⁷ But no one can enter the strong man's house and plunder his property unless he first ties up the strong man, and then he will plunder his house.

²⁸ "Truly I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the sons *and daughters* of men, and whatever blasphemies they commit; ²⁹ but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin"— ³⁰ because they were saying, "He has an unclean (demonic) spirit."

Notes:

Luke 12:8-10

⁸ "Now I say to you, everyone who confesses Me before people, the Son of Man will also confess him before the angels of God; ⁹ but the one who denies Me before people will be denied before the angels of God. ¹⁰ And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but the one who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him.

Notes:

Matthew 12:22-39

Then a demon-possessed man who was blind and unable to speak was brought to Jesus, and He healed him so that the man who was unable to speak talked and could see. ²³ And all the crowds were amazed and were saying, "This man cannot be the Son of David, can he?" ²⁴ But when the Pharisees heard this, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."

²⁵ And knowing their thoughts, *Jesus* said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself is laid waste; and no city or house divided against itself will stand. ²⁶ And if Satan is casting out Satan, he has become divided against himself; how then will his kingdom stand? ²⁷ And if by Beelzebul I cast out the demons, by whom do your sons cast *them* out? Therefore, they will be your judges. ²⁸ But if I cast out the demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you. ²⁹ Or, how can anyone enter the strong man's house and carry off his property, unless he first ties up the strong *man*? And then he will plunder his house.

³⁰ The one who is not with Me is against Me; and the one who does not gather with Me scatters.

³¹ "Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven. ³² And whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come.

³³ "Either assume the tree *to be* good as well as its fruit good, or assume the tree *to be* bad as well as its fruit bad; for the tree is known by its fruit. ³⁴ You offspring of vipers, how can you, being evil, express *any* good things? For the mouth speaks from that which fills the heart. ³⁵ The good person brings out of *his* good treasure good things; and the evil person brings out of *his* evil treasure evil things. ³⁶ But I tell you that *for* every careless word that people speak, they will give an account of it on *the* day of judgment. ³⁷ For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

³⁸ Then some of the scribes and Pharisees said to Him, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You." ³⁹ But He answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation craves a sign...

Helpful Passages in Hebrews

Hebrews 6:4-6

For it is impossible, in the case of those who have once been enlightened and have tasted of the heavenly gift and have been made partakers of the Holy Spirit, ⁵ and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, ⁶ and *then* have fallen away, to restore them again to repentance, since they again crucify to themselves the Son of God and put Him to open shame.

Hebrews 10:26-31

²⁶ For **if we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,** ²⁷ but a terrifying expectation of judgment and the fury of a fire which will consume the adversaries. ²⁸ Anyone who has ignored the Law of Moses is put to death without mercy on *the testimony of* two or three witnesses. ²⁹ How much more severe punishment do you think he will deserve who has trampled underfoot the Son of God, and has **regarded as unclean the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has insulted the Spirit of grace?** ³⁰ For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay." And again, "The Lord will judge His people." ³¹ It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God.
